

## Report on Student Satisfaction Survey Analysis

Name of the College: **Late Sow. Kamaltai Jamkar Mahila Mahavidyalaya, Parbhani**

Academic Year: **2019-2020**

### • **Rationale:**

The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is one of the mandatory criteria set by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). It is also a pre qualifier for Assessment and Accreditation of the institution. It collects in-depth data of students' feedback regarding teaching, learning and evaluation system of the college. The student responses are collected and analyzed to enhance the quality in higher education by incorporating their suggestions in teaching, learning and evaluation process and other related facilities like library resources, sport facilities, pure drinking water, washroom, toilets and separate ladies room etc.

### • **Methodology:**

The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) is aimed at collecting factual opinion of students on curriculum, completion of syllabus, preparedness of the teachers, reaction of the students regarding pedagogy, attitude of teachers, transparency and fairness in internal evaluations, placement possibilities, curricular and extra-curricular activities, overall impression and suggestions about the college.

The student responses were collected through the Google form of 21 questions made available on college official website <http://www.lskjmm.org>. This Google form consists of twenty objective type questions varies from 0-4 scale (like below 29%, 30 to 54%, 55 to 69%, 70 to 84% and 85 to 100%) and one open ended question. 95% students are the first and only time respondent of this survey. This SSS is analyzed by the external faculty to maintain impartiality and transparency.

### • **Analysis and the findings:**


**202** students responded to the SSS and imparted their valuable suggestions. The following analysis and findings are a fruit of it.





1. **89%** students (180 out of 202 students) are fully satisfied with the quality of teaching, learning and evaluation system of the college.
2. The college provides ample opportunities to the students for promoting internship, students exchange and field visit.
3. **68%** students are agree with rigorous efforts of the institution to engage students in the monitoring, review and continue quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
4. **83%** Students appreciated teaching method of teachers and their student centric methods like participative learning for enhancing learning experiences and **91%** students are happy with teachers' encouragement for participation in extracurricular activities.
5. The students have expressed satisfaction regarding the institution's efforts for inculcation of soft skills, life skills and employability skills.
6. Teacher's use of ICT tools and appropriate teaching pedagogy, availability of learning resources in the library, awareness about academic activities and sport facilities have been rated high by the students.

The Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) has also pointed out few grey areas where the college does have scope for enhancement in quality of education. They are as follows:

1. Institute needs to look after the cleanliness of classrooms, washrooms and canteen and availability of a separate ladies room with washroom facilities and add incinerators for sanitary pad disposal being special girls' college in our university.
2. Inclusion of English subject (MA English) in post graduate programmes.
3. Active mentorship for competitive examination and career guidance.
4. Enhance use of ICT in teaching and add more e-resources in the library.
5. Emphasis on skill development and inclusion of seminars, workshops and field visits for demanded subject.

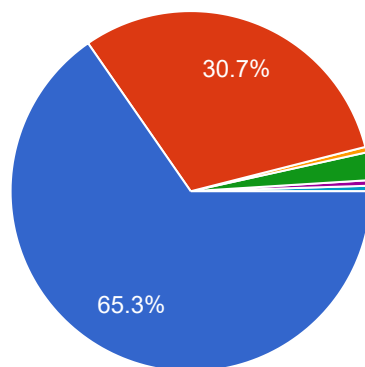

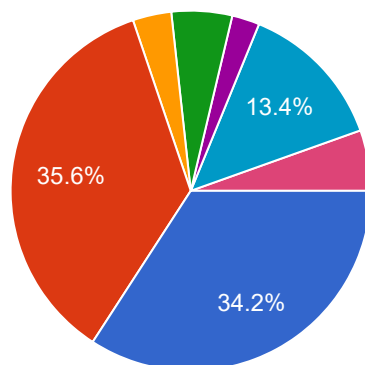

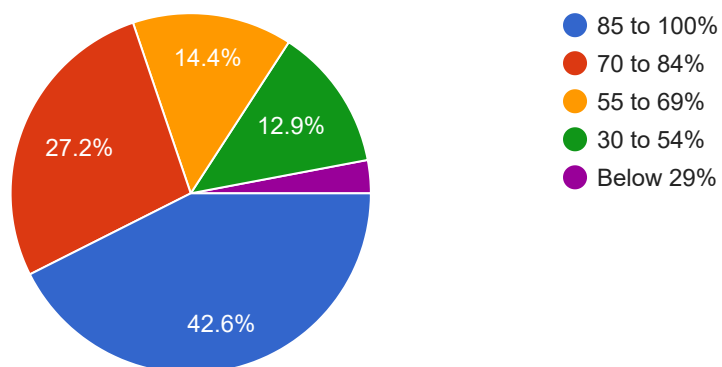

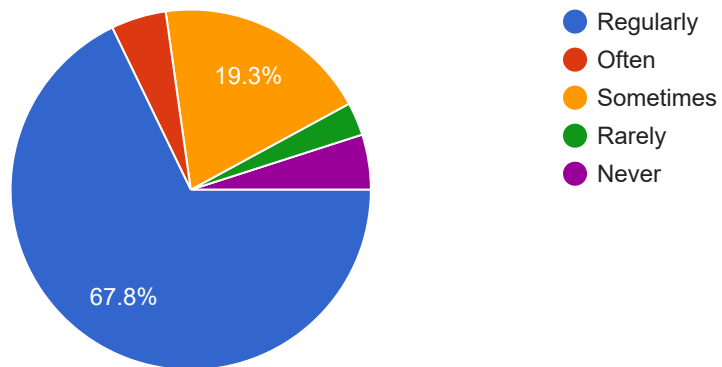

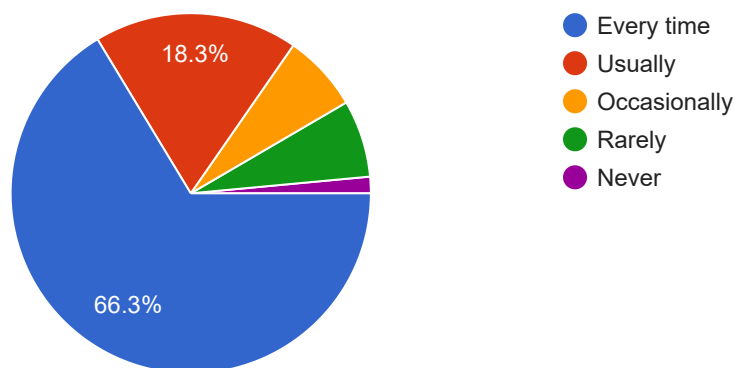

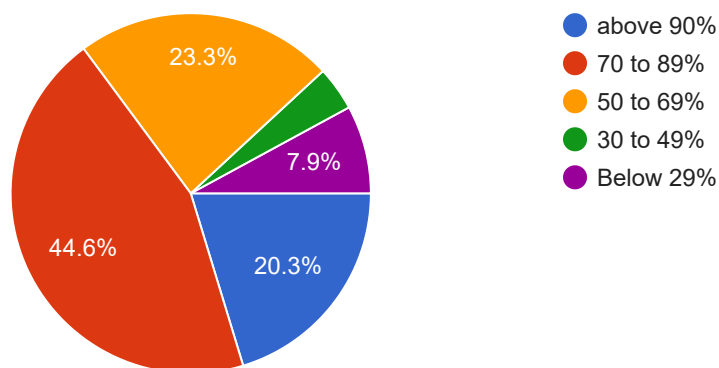

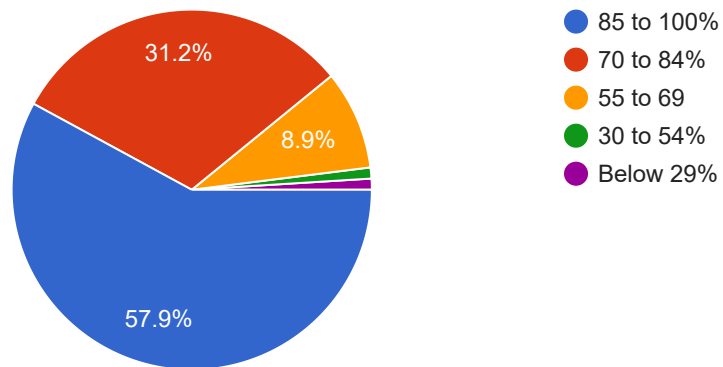
9. The teacher use ICT tools like LCD Projector, multimedia etc. while teaching and in what extent?

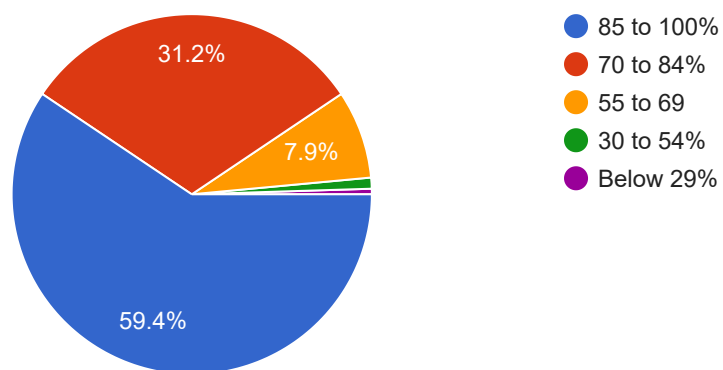

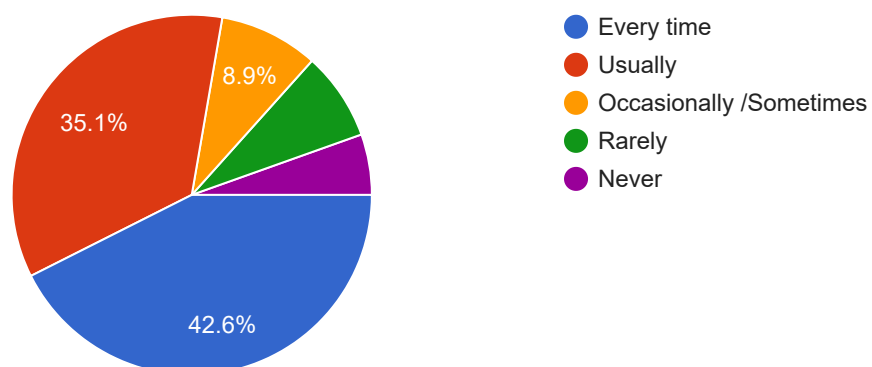

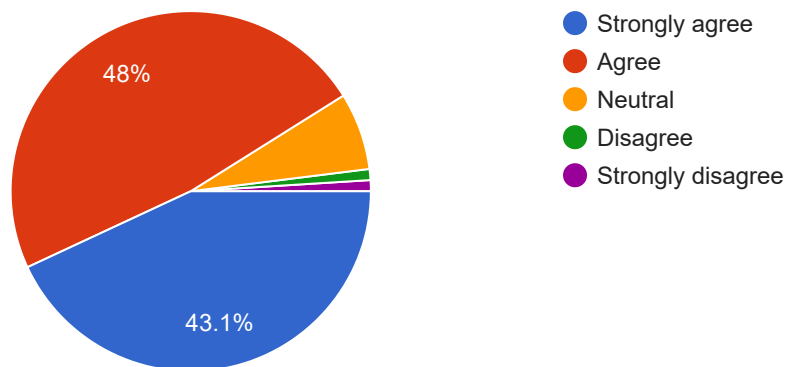
