The Context

Man is a social animal and half of the human beings are women. We are closely associated with the society. There are so many social problems prevalent in the society such as child labour, dowry, female foeticide, domestic violence etc. To try to remove these problems, one has to come forward. There are a number of people working in these fields. However, women who work for the welfare of society are appreciated by our College by conferring on them the 'Darpan Puraskar' in appreciation of their contribution. The College runs this activity from the last 22 years. 'Darpan Puraskar' is conferred to those women who are actively working in the fields of social, educational and in uplifting the weaker sections of the society. Our late President, Bharat Bhushan Shri Raosaheb Jamkar decided to confer on the 'Darpan Puraskar' in the memory of his wife, Late Sow Kamaltai Jamkar to the women who are working for the welfare of the society. Our College is purely Women's College. Promoting women for education, this College was established in June, 1983. Women are generally neglected by the society from longer periods that is why our late President had decided to bring women in social and educational streams and to achieve and complete the main purpose of the College. We confer this award on behalf of the College since last 22 years. This award took a dive from local to international in this last 22 years.

The Practice

The Institution has formed a separate committee entitled as the 'Darpan Puraskar Selection Committee'. The members of the committee take efforts to identify and finalize the name of the woman who is actively working in the field of social work. The committee collects the whole information of herand prepares a report on her overall social contributions. After discussion, on the individual work, her contribution to the society, the committee finalizes the name for 'Darpan Puraskar'. After that, the committee declares the name. After declaration,

the College organizes programme for awarding the Puraskar. The College invites all the people from the society to attend the programme. The nature of the Puraskar is shawl, bouquet, cash prize of Rs. 11000/-, sriphal (coconut), momento, Letter of Honour along with T.A and D.A. They are felicitated at the hands of eminent personalities. For this, the entire fund is raised by the College through its own funds.

Evidences of Success

The commencement of the Puraskar is from the year 1997. Till today, 18 women are the recipients of the 'Darpan Puraskar'. These women are invited from State as well as National levels. Even, the committee tried to consider the name from the International level like the Nobel Laureate, Malala Yusufzai, but due to security reasons and non availability of the recipient, hence, the college invited other recipient. The Context:-

Teachers, students and administrative staff play an important role for the College development. By considering the performance and contribution of them in college activities and overall working, the College has taken initiative to felicitate the teachers, students and administrative staff. So, the College has decided to confer on the award to those who give their best performance in all respects. The College has started the 'Late Sow. Kamaltai Jamkar Memorial Award' for women (teacher, student and administrative staff) and the 'Late Subhedar Bandhu Memorial Award' for men (teacher and administrative staff). Moreover, the college also appreciates the academic performance of the students through prize distribution to meritorious students.

The Practice

The 'Late Sow. Kamaltai Jamkar Memorial Award' was instituted during the Academic Year, 2016-17 and the 'Late Subhedar Bandhu Memorial Award' in the year 2017-18. The 'Late Sow Kamaltai Jamkar Memorial Award' was distributed on the occasion of the birth anniversary of the Late Sow Kamaltai Jamkar i.e. on 3rd September. The 'Late Subhedar Bandhu Memorial

Award' was distributed on the occasion of the death anniversary of the Late Subhedar Bandhu i.e. on 7th October. For both, the College has constituted committees. The committee members collect the information of the teaching and non-teaching staff and the students. They discuss on it and lastly finalize the names of the persons unanimously. The nature of the 'Late Sow. Kamaltai Memorial Award' is a cash prize of Rs. 5000/-, Certificate, Shawl, Sriphal (Coconut). The nature of the 'Late Subhedar Bandhu Memorial Award' is the felicitation of the concerned teacher andthe non-teaching employee. The committee declares the name of the person for the award and distributes it during the next year. The HEI organises the programme on 3rd September and 7th October respectively.

Prizes are the symbols of achievement, hard work, educational success and attainment of personal goals. This is a motivation for many for achieving higher level of success. This provides a tangible reminder of what is possible and it provides an opportunity for self-development. All the faculty members have taken initiatives to inspire the students by conferring oneligible students a cash prize of Rs. 1000/- as a merit prize. The students who obtain the highest marks in the final year in a particular optional subject are eligible for the prize. This activity has been started from the academic year2016-17 by our College. The prizes are distributed on the occasion of Hon'ble 'Late Sow. Kamaltai Jamkar Birth Anniversary' i.e. on 3rd September. Due to this activity, the result performances of the College students increased significantly.
