Introduction:

Activities of the Department:

Independence Day:

The Independence Day of our country is a moment of pride and glory. On this special occasion, rich tributes are paid to the freedom fighters, which sacrificed their lives and fought to free their motherland from the clutches of the oppressors – British who ruled the country. The British had initially come for trade but gradually took over the total administration of the country. At midnight of the August 15, 1947, India shook off the shackles of British Rule and became free. It was a night of celebration all over the country. On the 15th August 2014 the flag hosting ceremony was done by the Hon'ble Shri Hemantrao Jamkar, President, Nutan Vidya Mandir Education Society, Parbhani, in the presence of all the Management body, teaching and non-teaching staff and the students.

Sports day Celebrations on 29th August 2014:

The National Sports Day is celebrated on 29th August 2014, this day marks the birthday of Major Dhyan Chand, the hockey player who won gold medals in Olympics for India in the years 1928, 1934 and 1936. He scored over 400 goals in his career, from 1926 to 1948. After putting his stamp on international hockey arena, and having served his country to reach its pinnacles of glory multiple times. He is a legendary figure in the Indian and world hockey. The most noted memorials for him is the Major Dhyan Chand Award, the highest award for lifetime achievement in sports and games in India , and the National Sport day celebrations on his birthday. Our institution is also wants to improve the personality of our students through various activities. On the occasion of national sports day the department celebrated this day by giving the honor to the photo of Major Dhyan Chand.

Marathwada Mukti Sangram Din and Swami Ramanand Teerth Marathwada University Foundation Day:

On this occasion people gather around the "Marathwada Liberation Day Monument" and pay tribute to the ones who were killed during the struggle for independence. We also celebrate the Foundation day of our Parent University on the 17th September 2014. The Indian flag hosting ceremony was done by the Hon'ble Freedom Fighter Shri. Chavan and the University Flag Hosted by the Principal Dr. Avinash Sarnaik in the presence of teaching staff, non-teaching staff and the students.

Event of Dahi Handi

The motive for organizing this kind of event was, to inspire girls for participating social events and to improve their coordination and focus for the team events. This event teaches us that how to believe in other person and how to coordinate with our team mate. The event involves making a human pyramid and breaking an earthen pot filled with milk, curd, butter, fruits and water which is hung at a convenient height, thus imitating the actions of child Krishna. The terms Govinda (also another name of Krishna) or Govinda Pathak are used to refer to the people who participate in forming this human pyramid. But our institution wants to give this kind of freedom to our girl students, that's why the management decided to do this event for the girls. They practiced in group weeks before the actual event. Pyramid formation needs coordination and focus; the lowest layers consist of the most number of people, preferably sturdy, while the middle layer players need to pay attention to those below as well as the others standing on their shoulders. This event was organized in the month of 3rd October 2014 by the department of sports. In this event BA, BCOM and BCA these teams was participated and the event was win by BA.



Republic Day:

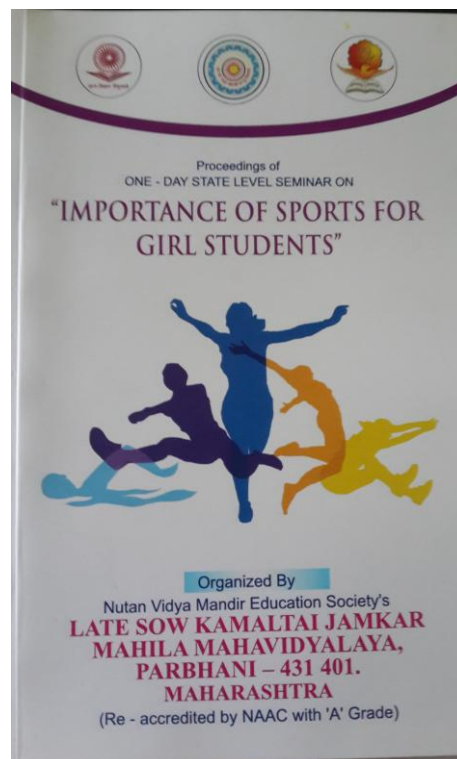
