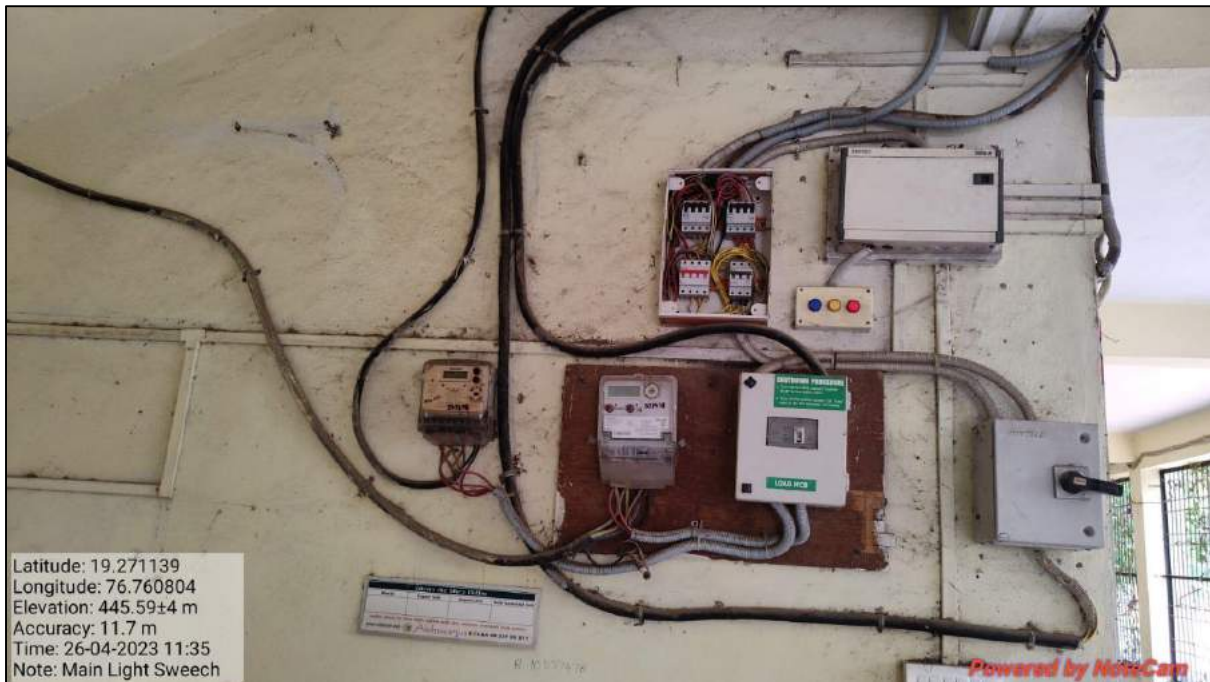

Solid Waste Management



 WET WASTE	 DRY WASTE	 SANITARY WASTE	 HAZARDOUS HOUSEHOLD WASTE
<p>What is it? It refers to organic, maybe damp waste that is biodegradable and can be composted.</p> <p>Items such as: Vegetable and fruit peels, rotten vegetables and fruits, leftover cooked food, mango seeds, used tea bags, used coffee powders, egg shells, rotten eggs, used flowers and leaves, spoiled spices, dust, meat, bones and non-veg food remains, finger and toe nails, hair, pet food.</p> <p>How to dispose it: Drain all liquid from individual items before they go into your dustbin, and do NOT put them in a plastic bag. Most wet waste should be handed over within 24hrs without using a plastic cover or bag.</p> <p>Coconut shells (hard and tender) and Fibre: Hand these over separately so that they can be used as fuel. They take ages to compost. If you want to put it with wet waste, you must cut the shells into small chips/pieces.</p>	<p>What is it? It includes non-biodegradable items and consists of both recyclable and non-recyclable materials.</p> <p>Items such as: Mop cloth, toilet brush, cleaning scrubs, door mats, plastic bottles and containers, toothbrushes, soap covers, chocolate wrappers, butter paper, milk pouches, ghee and oil packets, idli and other batter packets, oil cans, packages of food items, expired food packets (such as bread, biscuits, ready-to-eat food), newspapers, pen, pencil, eraser, used razors, shampoo and cosmetic containers, empty perfume bottles, thermacol, plastic covers with silver lining inside, shoes, tetra packs, small cartons and boxes, toothpaste tubes, tin bottles and cans, brooms, tissue paper, cushions, cling wraps, aluminium foils.</p> <p>How to dispose it: This does not need to be disposed of immediately. You can hand it over to recyclers or get it collected at regular intervals.</p>	<p>What is it? This is non-hazardous and non-radioactive waste that largely originates from humans and sometimes, pests.</p> <p>Items such as: Sanitary pads, panty liners, waxing strips, diapers, used rindoms, dental floss, used earbuds, used syringes, used cotton and bandages, any piece of cloth, paper stained with blood, or medical waste, dead cockroaches, rats, lizards, etc.</p> <p>How to dispose it: Wrap in newspaper and mark with a red cross. Hand them over separately, not with your wet or dry waste.</p>	<p>What is it? It covers items that pose a threat to human health and/or the environment and need special disposal.</p> <p>Items such as: Broken glass, old paint, expired cosmetics, expired medicines, cans of mosquito sprays, insecticides, room fresheners, fluorescent, syrup bottles, injection bottles, other medicinal discards, mosquitoes repellent mats, used Odoral, CFLs, tubelights, clock or watch pieces, thermometer, credit/debit cards with chip, button cells, CDs and old cassettes, printer cartridges, pieces of wires, old electronic parts, old phones, adapters, chargers, and other types of e-waste.</p> <p>How to dispose it: Drain any liquids, hand them over separately to the collector or at a collection centre with care. If broken, pack well in newspaper and hand over. Do not mix with other waste.</p>

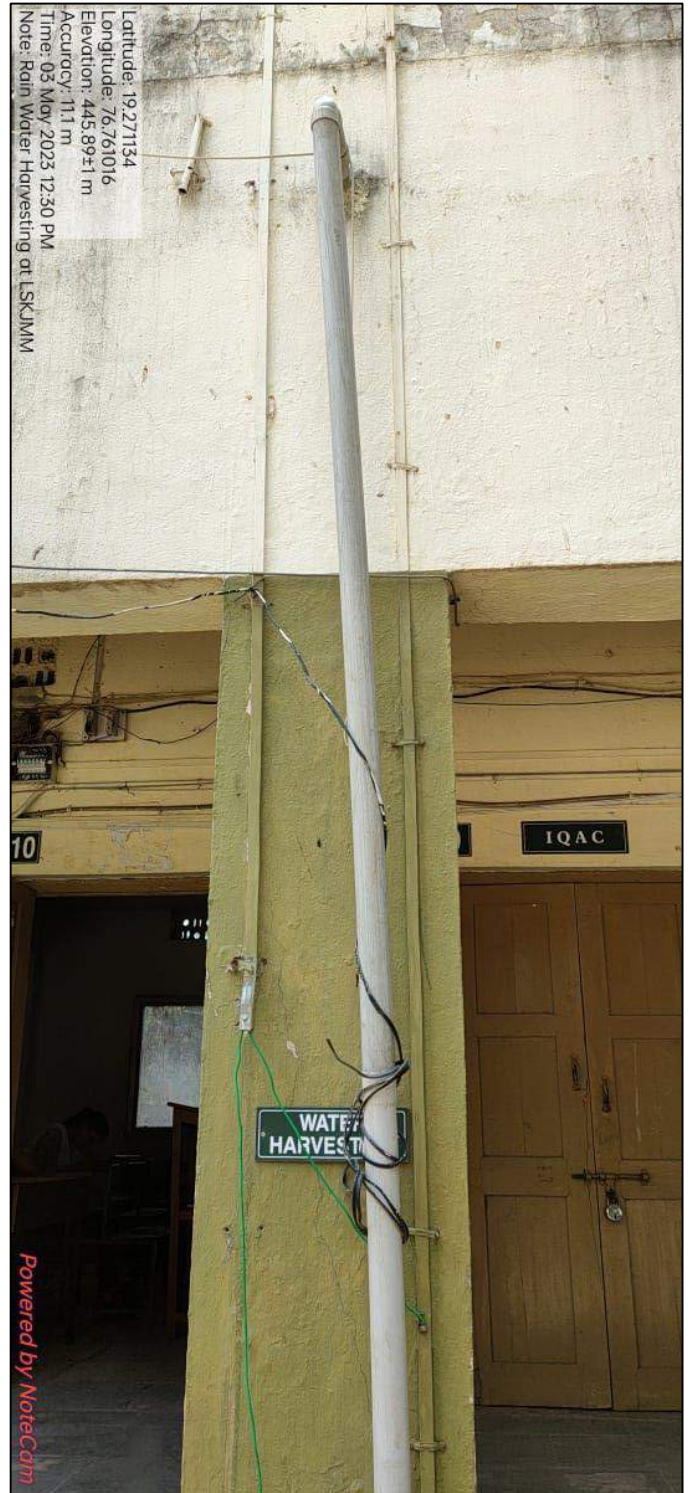

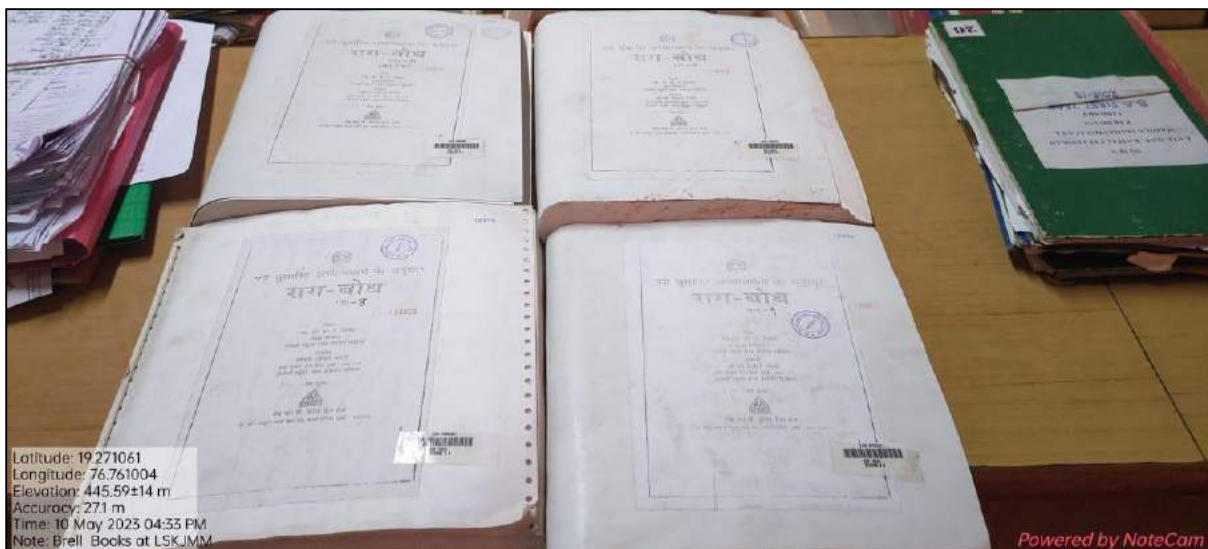
